Shikoku Electric Power Group (STNet, Inc.) Launches Sales of SecuAvail's Next-Generation AI-SOC Service Enabling Autonomous Security Operations in the Shikoku Region

SecuAvail Inc. (Head Office: Kita-ku, Osaka; President: Masaomi Yoneima; Securities Code: 3042; hereinafter "SecuAvail"), a specialized IT security company, announces that STNet, Inc. (Head Office: Takamatsu City, Kagawa; President: Isao Kobayashi; hereinafter "STNet"), a member of the Shikoku Electric Power Group, will commence sales of SecuAvail's AI-SOC (Security Operation Center) service from April 17.

Through this initiative, in addition to "NetStare®," a security operations service for mid-sized and large enterprises that has been offered in collaboration with SecuAvail, STNet will also be able to provide "AI-SOC" for small and medium-sized enterprises. This will enable STNet to deliver security operations services to a broader range of customers.

In recent years, regardless of company size, the use of cloud services for business applications and interconnectivity for information exchange across companies through supply chain networks have made the effective utilization of the Internet indispensable for business operations. Furthermore, office applications have been shifting from traditional on-premises environments to cloud-based services such as Microsoft 365, accelerating the adoption of collaboration tools—such as Teams and SharePoint—that are premised on file sharing via cloud storage.

On the other hand, the operation of security devices and the management of security functions for platforms such as Microsoft 365 have become increasingly siloed, limiting integrated security operations and resulting in a growing burden on corporate IT operations personnel.

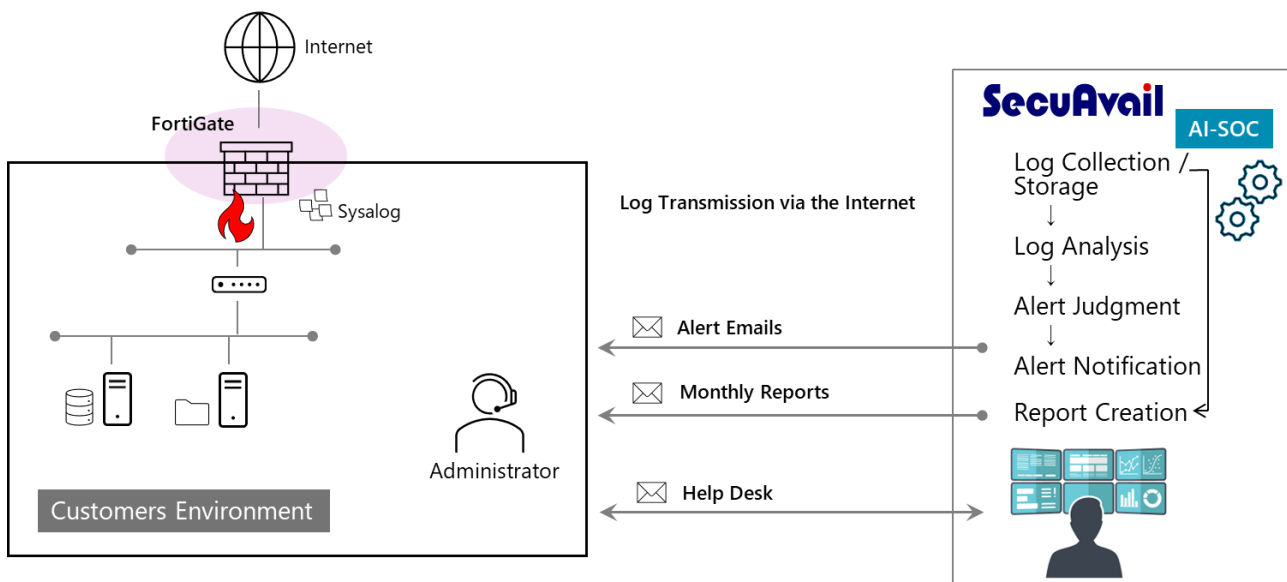
To address these challenges, AI-SOC is a next-generation SOC service that leverages SecuAvail's approximately 25 years of accumulated expertise in security operations since its founding, together with the AI-driven log analysis capabilities of the "LogStare" security operations platform developed by its group company, LogStare Inc. Through these capabilities, AI-SOC achieves both the automation of SOC operations and cost efficiency.

The lineup includes "AI-SOC for FortiGate," which analyzes FortiGate communication logs to detect unauthorized access and potential data exfiltration resulting from potentially malicious internal activities, and "AI-SOC for Microsoft 365," which analyzes Microsoft 365 audit logs to identify security-critical events. STNet plans to market these services primarily to users of its in-house data center service "Powerico" and its Internet connectivity service "STIA."

Until now, AI-SOC has been provided exclusively through distributors; however, STNet has become the first sales partner to offer the service directly to end users, and the two companies will jointly conduct promotional activities.

Furthermore, taking this opportunity, SecuAvail will expand the supported device lineup for “AI-SOC for FortiGate” and offer two versions: (i) a version compatible with FortiGate 30, 40, and 50, and (ii) a version compatible with FortiGate 60, 70, 80, and 90, which will be provided to STNet on a preferential basis.
