Notice Concerning Acquisition of Shares of Aiwa Co., Ltd. (to Make It a Subsidiary)

Fibergate Inc. (the “Company”) hereby announces that it has acquired all outstanding shares of Aiwa Co., Ltd. (Headquarters: Yamato-shi, Kanagawa; “Aiwa”), which is engaged in telecommunications construction and network camera installation, and make it a subsidiary. The details are described below.

1. Reason for acquisition of shares

As an on-premise infrastructure integrator, the Company Group has established a structure through which it provides end-to-end communication network engineering, construction, and maintenance for apartment complexes, commercial facilities, and other properties, and is expanding its services across Japan. With the goal of significantly expanding its in-house construction capabilities within its Telecom Business, the Group has adopted this resolution as a crucial first step.

For more than four decades since its founding, Aiwa has provided dependable technology and services spanning a broad range of telecommunications fields, including internet, cable TV, and network camera installations, primarily in Japan’s Kanagawa Prefecture. Particularly noteworthy is Aiwa’s robust business foundation that facilitates the securing of contracts directly from major corporations as a prime contractor. With a staff rich in certified professionals—among them analog and digital installation technicians and electricians—Aiwa prides itself on its field-oriented response capabilities and its strength in coordinating multiple partner companies.

In terms of synergy generated by the addition of Aiwa to the Company Group, the reinforcement of the Group’s construction capabilities in the telecommunications sector is most prominent. Amidst the rapid advancement of digitalization and adoption of AI, the Group is convinced that the “technical expertise of construction workers” and “on-site management capabilities” that support operations—the human touch and construction skills that connect people—remain two crucial sources of competitive advantage. Through this partnership, the Company Group will leverage the technical expertise of construction workers cultivated by Aiwa over many years along with its network of partner companies in contributing to further development of the Telecom Business and enhancing the value it provides.

Moreover, this year, the Company Group has adopted “Lead The ‘Telecomenergy’” as its new slogan. It embodies the Group’s strong commitment to the vertical integration of “telecommunications (nervous system),” which it has long made efforts to advance and “energy (bloodstream),” including renewable energy, and to

transitioning to a next-generation urban infrastructure model. The merging of Aiwa’s proven construction capabilities with the Group’s existing services will contribute directly to the expansion and in-house development of its construction capabilities for building the next-generation infrastructure model envisioned by “Telecomenergy.” The Company’s aim is to further enhance the value of its core telecommunications services by solidifying its construction foundation in the telecommunications infrastructure sector. At the same time, the Company will accelerate the societal implementation of next-generation urban infrastructure models that integrate “telecommunications” and “energy,” with the goal of achieving further groupwide business expansion and growth.
