Notice Regarding the Opening of the Sapporo Office

SecuAvail Inc. hereby announces that it will open a new office in Sapporo, Hokkaido, effective August 1, 2026, as outlined below.

1. Background to the Opening of the Sapporo Office

The SecuAvail Group has developed its core business by providing network security services to a wide range of organizations, including government agencies, universities, hospitals, and private enterprises, supporting critical social infrastructure.

Beyond pursuing short-term business objectives, we are committed to fulfilling our broader social mission as a service-oriented corporate group. As part of this commitment, we continue to strengthen our business foundation throughout Japan, and the establishment of the Sapporo Office represents another important step in expanding our nationwide presence.

On February 18, 2026, the Company completed a dual listing on the Main Market of the Sapporo Securities Exchange in addition to the Standard Market of the Tokyo Stock Exchange. The purpose of the dual listing is to enhance the Company's recognition in the Hokkaido region and strengthen relationships with local individual investors and businesses.

The newly established Sapporo Office will serve as a strategic base for expanding our sales activities to government agencies, local governments, universities, medical institutions, and private-sector enterprises throughout Hokkaido. It will also strengthen collaboration with regional business partners and promote wider adoption of the Company's service portfolio, including the AI-SOC series.

The office will also be responsible for developing and expanding relationships with regional business partners.

3. Company Overview

Since its establishment in 2001, SecuAvail Inc. has specialized in network security and is one of Japan's few dedicated IT security companies. The Company provides security solutions and operational support for information systems used by corporations, government agencies, local governments, universities, and healthcare institutions.

For more than 20 years, the Company has provided **NetStare**, its integrated security operations service. NetStare is one of the few services in the industry that combines both a Security Operations Center (SOC) and a Network Operations Center (NOC) within a single platform. The service continuously monitors approximately 11,000 network devices and collects and analyzes approximately 2.5 billion log records every day, enabling the early detection of equipment failures, network disruptions, and cyberattacks through a 24-hour, 365-day monitoring operation.

In addition, the SecuAvail Group has incorporated the security monitoring and operational expertise accumulated over the past 25 years into the AI capabilities of its proprietary, **Japan-developed security operations platform, LogStare**. Leveraging this expertise, the Group offers its next-generation **AI-SOC** service portfolio.

The **AI-SOC** series utilizes advanced AI-powered log analysis to automate security monitoring and generate alerts accompanied by recommended response procedures. The service is complemented by a 24-hour, 365-day help desk staffed by experienced security professionals, enabling organizations that do not have dedicated cybersecurity personnel to benefit from highly efficient, high-quality security operations. As a result, the solution helps reduce operational workloads while strengthening organizations' overall cybersecurity posture.

Leveraging its proprietary, Japan-developed security operations platform, the SecuAvail Group will continue to expand its service delivery capabilities for customers throughout Hokkaido and across Japan. Through these efforts, the Group remains committed to contributing to the realization of a safer and more secure digital society.

4. Outlook

The establishment of the Sapporo Office is expected to have only a minimal impact on the Group's consolidated financial results for the fiscal year ending March 31, 2027.
